










# Château Le Moulin

# 2010

	WINE SPECTATOR	<b>Mars 2011 :</b>  /  Sleek and restrained, with a gorgeous mouthfeel, as silky tannins are already lengthy, carrying the spice, linzer torte, crushed cherry and red currant fruit. A classy wine. <i>Barrel tasting.</i> J.M.
	ROBERT PARKER	<b>Avril 2011 :</b>  /  From lawyer and judge Michel Querre, Le Moulin is a somewhat under the radar Pomerol that I have always found to have a kinship to Le Pin, if only because of its exuberant exoticism. The deep ruby/purple-hued 2010 reveals layers of fruitcake, spice box, plum, black currant and cherry characteristics. Medium to full-bodied, deep and already irresistible, it may have slightly high acids and a lower pH than usual, but it is a big, loaded Pomerol that should drink well for 12-15+ years.
<i>TAST</i>	TAST	<b>Avril 2011 : 16-17/20</b> Nez profond qui fait saliver on aime cette fraîcheur aromatique, la bouche est d'un charme fou avec son attaque suave et florale sur l'œillet et la pivoine et des tanins longs et fondants. Vin qui rayonne en fin de bouche. C'est une nouvelle fois l'une des réussites du millésime sur le secteur.
	JEAN-MARC QUARIN	<b>Avril 2011 : 15.75-16/20</b> Couleur sombre, pourpre. Nez fin, fruité, frais et truffé. Bouche savoureuse, très fruitée, de corpulence normale. Le millésime possède la touche très avenante du cru, avec du goût.
	DECANTER	<b>Avril 2011 : 17/20</b> Modern, rich and opulent in style. Plenty of extract but not over worked. Smooth, velvety texture. Some freshness behind. Good length. Drink 2015-2023. (17 points)
	JANCIS ROBINSON	<b>Avril 2011 : 16/20</b> Sweet black cherry nose - as though it weren't 2010! A bit simple and gassy but covers the bases. Greenish finish. Full bodied, savoury. Drink 2016-2026
