 <p>Antonio Galloni vinous explore all things wine</p>	<p>Décembre 2018 :  92</p> <p>The 2016 Le Moulin is supple and fruity, both of which give the wine much of its immediacy and overall appeal. Silky and plush on the palate, the 2016 has much to offer. Super-ripe red cherry, plum, menthol, spice and new leather all fill out the wine's ample, creamy frame. The 2016 is not especially complex, but it is elegant and impeccably balanced. Alain Raynaud consults. Drinking window: 2021-2031</p> <p>Avril 2017 :  /  89 / 92</p> <p>The 2016 Le Moulin is plump, juicy and delicious, but not especially complex or exciting. Don't get me wrong – this is a gorgeous wine by any measure. At the same time, it's quite evident that there is considerable untapped potential. A rush of intense, super-ripe dark fruit, cherry jam, wildflowers and spice leads into the unctuous, full-bodied finish.</p>

Great Pomerol.</p> <p>Avril 2017 :  /  91 / 92</p> <p>A tight and solid red with blackberries, blueberries and chocolate. Medium-bodied, firm and silky.</p>
